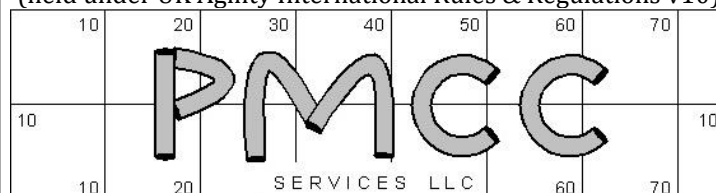

Chairs can be set up at the far end of the ring to the extent space is available.

TRIAL SITE RULES:

All dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in the ring. Exercise and toilet your dog in designated areas. Please poop and scoop and use garbage containers on the site. Please be courteous to others using the area. No aggressive dogs.

- **5 mph speed limit on the property.** Violators can be subject to a trial committee hearing. Tetz Lane is posted 30mph. It is strongly suggested that you go no faster than 10mph between the white house on the turn and the first red barn.

- Park only in designated areas as directed by trial officials. Do not block RV's!

- Please stay close to the barn! The fields, areas by the houses, the horse paddock area, and fenced runs in front of the building are all off limits.

- Crating is not permitted in the seating area of the arena. Crating is available in SOME of the stalls. It is convenient to work from your car, and there is plenty of room to tent/crate outside in the designated areas.

- During trial hours, dogs must be on leash at all times when not competing in the arena or at the practice jump. No flexi leashes in extension allowed in the barn or arena.

- No food or treats are to be left in the stalls or the arena overnight.

- No personal heaters of any kind - propane, kerosene or electric - are allowed in stalls, in any building or within 100 feet of any building.

- No smoking in any building or within 50 feet of any building. Cigarette butts must be properly disposed of.

- All trash is to be placed in proper receptacles, black/ garbage and blue/ recycling

- Clean up after your dog. The orange poop cans with bags are located outside.

- Unsupervised children are not allowed on or about the premises.

Location: Victoria Farms/Ramapo Search and Rescue, 120 Tetz Lane, Middletown, New York. Convenient to the NY Thruway, I-84, and NY-17.

From the NYS Thruway (North or South): Exit 16 - Merge onto NY-17 W Take exit 122 - Crystal Run Crossing. Turn right onto Crystal Run Crossing. Turn left onto Crystal Run Road. Take to end - make right at stop sign - County Rd 83/ Goshen Turnpike/ Scotchtown Ave. Approximately 1.2 miles to Tetz Lane - Victoria Farms sign on left. Left onto Tetz Lane to end. From the West: I-84 Eastbound - Take Exit 19A for NY-17 E towards New York City. Keep Right for County Rd 67/Crystal Run Rd. At traffic light, turn Left onto Crystal Run Rd, follow for 2 miles, turn Right at Stop Sign onto Goshen Turnpike/Scotchtown Ave. After 1.2 miles, turn Left onto Tetz Lane. Follow to end. From the East: I-84 Westbound - Take Exit 19A to merge onto NY-17 towards New York City. Take Exit 122 for County Rd 67/Crystal Run Rd. At traffic light, turn Left onto Crystal Run Rd, follow for 2 miles, turn Right at Stop Sign onto Goshen Turnpike/Scotchtown Ave. After 1.2 miles, turn Left onto Tetz Lane. Follow to end.

By entering this event, you, as the entrant, acknowledge that you are authorized to act on behalf of both yourself and any other UK Agility International (UKI) members who will participate under your entry and you agree to the following:

1. Assumption of Risk & Liability

The exhibitor/owner certifies that any and all dogs brought to the facility, whether participating or not, do not pose a hazard to persons, dogs, or property. The exhibitor/owner assumes full responsibility, liability, and any resulting expenses for any damages caused by their dog(s).

UK Agility International (UKI), UK Agility Ltd, their agents, officers, associates and members shall not be held liable for any loss, injury, damage, claims, demands, or liabilities involving your dog, yourself, or any third-party equipment. You agree to indemnify and hold harmless UKI and its representatives (including the club/group/ trial organizers, show management) from any claims, including legal fees, arising from injury or damages caused during participation in any event or training.

2. Hazards & Safety

The exhibitor/owner acknowledges all potential hazards associated with the training facility, event, and premises, including but not limited to:

The condition of the grounds; Lighting and security measures (or lack thereof); Electrical appliances and fittings; Parking areas and fencing; The potential for a dog to escape from the training or competition area; The presence of unfamiliar animals and people; The presence of other dogs; Agility equipment; Course design and course set up; The possibility of another ill animal or your own getting ill. The exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from any and all of these including allowing their dogs to run wearing collars, stop pad protectors, bitch in season pants, or any similar items.

By entering, you voluntarily assume any and all risks associated with these hazards and any other potential hazards not listed. All participants must exercise caution, monitor their dogs, and clean up after themselves and their animals.

3. Conduct & Enforcement

UK Agility International reserves the right to:

- **Excuse any participant** for what it deems excessive harshness toward a dog and for behavior considered aggressive or abusive toward another person or dog.
- **Revoke, suspend, or ban** any entry or membership at its sole discretion if deemed necessary to protect the interests of UK Agility and any of its associates, agents, officers, or members.

Participation in UKI events, including membership, is a **privilege, not a right**. UK Agility International has full authority to impose suspensions or bans without prior notice.

4. Rules & Regulations

By entering, you agree to comply with all UK Agility International Rules & Regulations, including any amendments. Additionally, you confirm that:

- You will not bring any dog that has been knowingly exposed to an infectious or contagious disease within 21 days prior to the event.
- To the best of your knowledge, your dog is not subject to disqualification under UK Agility International Show Regulations.

Measuring Dogs - Please ensure you understand the new criteria regarding dogs being measured. UKI Rule Book edition 10
If a dog is under 3 and newly registered, a temporary measure or proof of the dog's height must be done by the dog's 3rd trial. A permanent measure must be obtained by a UKI official measurer between 12-18 months after the dog's first/ temporary measure. Any registered dog that only has a temporary measure, must follow the above rule. If a newly registered dog is over 3, they must obtain a measure by an official UKI measurer by their 3rd trial and this measurement will be permanent.

BY ENTERING UKI EVENTS, COMPETITORS AGREE TO the following, and the terms and conditions listed on page 6

UK Agility International Rules and Regulations apply to the whole event and all people and dogs must comply with these at all times. As a competitor it is your responsibility to be aware of the rules and regulations as they stand at the time of the show. This show will run under the current edition UK Agility International rules found on the UKI web page.

Competitors through submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of **UK Agility International rules and regulations** including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry

Please ensure to read the **move up rules – section 2.0**. At a UKI trial where the dog is competing for more than one day and the dog completes the requirements for a level on a prior day, they must move up the following day.

All dogs and handlers must be registered with UK Agility International to compete. UK Agility International's official rules & regulations are available to view free from the UKI web page. If you or your dog is not already registered, please register online at www.ukagilityinternational.com

All dogs are entered at this show at their owners' risk and whilst every care will be taken the show management and UKI will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury however caused to dogs, persons or property while at the UKI event.

Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible to compete in UKI Trials, with the exception of dogs over 15 calendar months of age eligible to compete in Nursery Classes & Speedstakes classes.

A dog shall be withdrawn from competition without refund if it is: suffering from any infectious or contagious disease, interfering with the safety of any person or other animal or if it is likely to cause itself damage or its welfare is in danger if it continues competing.

It is expressly understood that competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children and guests. Any competitor whose dogs, children, or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, will at the discretion of the show management, be asked to remove the offending dogs, children, guests from the event grounds. Any competitor or competitor's dog that is dismissed from the show by the judge and or show manager in accordance with UKI rules and regulations will have no recourse to any refund of fees paid such as entry fees, camping fees, crating fees and any other fees associated with the event.

It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Handlers working more than one dog in a class **must ensure that the dogs compete in the sequence in which they are drawn**. Failure to do so will result in elimination.

Dogs left in hot cars, or dogs appearing to be in distress, will be dealt with as seen fit by the Show Management.

Should a judge be unable to fulfill the appointment to judge, the show management reserves the right to appoint another judge. Should circumstances so dictate the show manager, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to UK Agility International. In the event of abandonment of the show through circumstances beyond our control, the SHOW MANAGEMENT may defray such expenses from the entry fee to cover the cost of the show preparation. These accounts will then be made public.

Rules of Conduct:

UKI promotes dog agility pursuant to regulations consistent with international standards as a competitive, spectator sport. All competitors, officials, and event personnel shall conduct themselves in a professional and sportsmanlike manner consistent with the foregoing statement of purpose and seek to uphold, and enhance where possible, the image of the sport and UKI through such conduct and actions including on social media platforms.

By virtue of their entry, competitors acknowledge and agree to comply with all UKI rules and regulations and agree to accept any sanctions that are imposed for failure to comply. The judge has responsibility for determining when it is appropriate to excuse a dog and competitor from the ring. The show officials have responsibility for determining when an infraction should result in a verbal warning, written warning and/or expulsion of a competitor, dog, or any person from the event by conducting the procedure outlined in the UKI rule book. UKI head officials, through further investigation, may impose sanctions including suspension or expulsion from future events.

The following is a partial list of infractions on which the judge or trial officials will take action: Abuse of a dog on the grounds; actions that may have the appearance of abuse of a dog; willful misconduct or interference with a competitor's right to show; any acts of poor sportsmanship; violation of procedural rules; compulsive, correctional training on the grounds; willful misrepresentation on entry forms; willful misrepresentation of animals; dog aggression; failure to exercise diligence in the control of the behavior of their dog including a dog clearly not under the control of the handler; concerns for the welfare of a dog or who is unfit for competing; intimidation and/or impolite confrontation of judges, event officials, event helpers, or other competitors; creating excessive delays as a failure to respect the authority of event officials.

Social Media Conduct

Cyber bullying of any kind towards UKI, trial management & staff, competitors, judges, helpers or volunteers will not be tolerated. Examples of cyber bullying include but are not limited to, communications that seek to intimidate, manipulate, falsely discredit, put down, try to control, rudely confront, demand, and comments that try to incite further issues. Further, UKI is committed to maintaining an environment that is built on mutual respect and is free from racism, discrimination and harassment. In keeping with this goal, any behavior that is hateful towards race, color, religion, creed, national origin or ancestry, ethnicity, sex, and gender will not be tolerated. Any of these cases may sanction removal from all associated social media pages and even lead to expulsion of UKI events and even further expulsion of organization membership.

Refund and Entry Cancellation Policy

Entries will not be accepted, changed, or altered after the closing date or capping level has been reached except for the purpose of moving to a higher level. A full refund is available for any membership that is not older than 14 days from the date of account creation. A full refund is available before the closing date or capping level is met for any show. There will be no cost if refund money is to be left in your UKI account. If a refund is requested, a 5% administration fee for a credit card refund will be assessed, per transaction. ***After the closing date, a partial entry credit may be available for extraordinary circumstances, but this lies with the individual show management based on their own policies. Contact the show management for details, NOT UKI.***

Payment of entry fees and Instant Account Top up Fees must be made directly to the UKI member account or directly to the trial before a competitor may compete. PLEASE BE AWARE – at the closing date of entries, if you are paying by check, your account balance under “My Account” will show as \$0.00 USD. A note will confirm that you are paying the trial directly. This enables you to enter and pay for other trials online. If you have a \$0.00 USD zero balance display on your UKI Home page, it does not

constitute a cancelled entry. Only you are responsible to cancel your entry online by going back into the show you entered and clicking CANCEL MY ENTIRE ENTRY. UKI will not cancel any entries.
