Refunds:

There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date. A dog or handler which suffers an injury and/or illness or bitches that come into season after the closing date may be eligible for a refund up to 75% of their total entry fee. Requests for said refunds must be received in writing by the completion of the event on Sunday and must include documentation from your veterinarian or physician verifying the illness or injury. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, snow, acts of God, public emergency, an act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond our control.

A NATCH Rosette will be awarded to those who earn these titles during our trial. First through fourth placement ribbons will be awarded in all classes except Chances which is a pass/fail event.

The following obstacles will be available at this agility trial: Electronic Timers, **Slatted** rubber surfaced Dog Walk & A-Frame, Tunnels, Weaves, Jumps, Hoops, and Barrels.

Jump Height Info: Permanent Height Card Requirements and Updates

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.

- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but it cannot be used during your run, nor can you indicate to the dog it is there. **All Handlers may bring** a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement / entry form represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases **NADAC** (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), **Skyline Agility Club, Inc** (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and **Ramapo Search & Rescue Foundation** (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. From the NYS Thruway (North or South): Exit 16 - Merge onto NY- 17 W Take exit 122 - Crystal Run Crossing. Turn right onto Crystal Run Crossing. Turn left onto Crystal Run Road. Take to end - make right at stop sign - County Rd 83/ Goshen Turnpike/ Scotchtown Ave. Approximately 1.2 miles to Tetz Lane - Victoria Farms sign on left. Left onto Tetz Lane to end.

From the West – I-84 Eastbound – Take Exit 19A for NY-17 E towards New York City. Keep Right for County Rd 67/Crystal Run Rd. At traffic light, turn Left onto Crystal Run Rd, follow for 2 miles, turn Right at Stop Sign onto Goshen Turnpike/Scotchtown Ave. After 1.2 miles, turn Left onto Tetz Lane. Follow to end.

From the East – I-84 Westbound – Take Exit 19A to merge onto NY-17 towards New York City. Take Exit 122 for County Rd 67/Crystal Run Rd. At traffic light, turn Left onto Crystal Run Rd, follow for 2 miles, turn Right at Stop Sign onto Goshen Turnpike/Scotchtown Ave. After 1.2 miles, turn Left onto Tetz Lane. Follow to end.

ALL generators must use a mechanism (Gen-Turi or suitable exhaust hose) to direct on-board generator exhaust away from neighboring RVs. Unless extreme weather conditions or other circumstances please turn off all generators by 11 PM.

1. Park as directed by the RV Coordinator.
2. Please take your garbage to the end of the property where you will find the large garbage bin Do not take your RV garbage to the barn containers. Place recycling in containers provided in barn.
3. Dogs cannot be left outside all night.
4. Additional guidance will be emailed to you prior to the trial by the RV coordinator.
